RHS Boys Lacrosse FAQ

Is a USA Lacrosse Membership Required?

Yes, these memberships are required by the Oregon High School Lacrosse governing body and provide insurance coverage for your player. **THIS MUST BE CURRENT TO PLAY**

What equipment does my son need?

The club has limited equipment to loan and we work to accommodate as many players as possible. **Players should purchase their own cleats, gloves, elbow pads and chest protectors to best fit them and their budget.** Players need NOCSAE certified shoulder pads, elbow pads, gloves and a stick to play. Starter packs can be purchased from Dicks or Lacrosse Unlimited. Check with Coach Dever and Coach Watson if you have equipment needs.

Does my son need a physical to play?

Yes, even though we are a club sport we are hosted by Roseburg High School and follow all OSAA regulations for high school players. **YOU MUST HAVE A CURRENT PHYSICAL TO PLAY**

Is there financial aid for the registration fee?

Yes, We are happy to hear that players are getting the Every Kids Sports scholarship. For frequently asked questions about the scholarship and it's funds please visit. <https://everykidsports.org>. This can cover up to around \$150.00 of your registration fee if you qualify!

ROSEBURG LACROSSE CLUB 2024 FINANCIAL COMMITMENT FORM

As a non-profit registration fees cover transportation costs, OHSLA fees, referees, coaches and team protective equipment.

TEAM DUES (Check one option)

One-time full payment \$275.00 full registration payment. Due by February 23rd

\$100 Family discount for multiple athletes - (\$100 of total registration *not* off of each player Ex: 2 players in one family would total \$450.00 registration fees)

FUNDRAISING

Roseburg Lacrosse Club is not supported financially by the Roseburg School District. All costs associated with running the program, including field equipment, referees, coaches, transportation, league fees, uniforms, etc. are paid directly by the program. Every registration due and fundraising dollar is critical. **Each athlete and family is expected to participate in fundraising. The goal is for each player to raise a minimum of \$150 during the current season. Players will be required to participate in mandatory fundraisers.**

EQUIPMENT DEPOSIT (separate from registration dues)

Each player must submit a \$200 refundable deposit before equipment can be distributed. ***This deposit will need to be a separate check from your regular Roseburg Lacrosse Club dues.*** Checks, or cash will be returned when equipment is returned at the end of the season or shredded if you authorize us to do so. If equipment is returned damaged, a portion of the deposit will be used to cover the replacement costs. Please indicate below what you would like to be done with your \$200 equipment deposit check. Equipment is defined as ***any*** items loaned by the club in part or as a whole, sticks, protective pads, uniforms, helmets.

Roseburg Lacrosse Club has my permission to shred my equipment deposit check at the end of the season once my player has returned all their equipment.

Roseburg Lacrosse Club will return my equipment deposit check to me at the end of the season once my player has returned all their equipment.

SCHOLARSHIP SPONSORSHIP (optional)
